

CHAPTER 2 NATIONAL SYMBOLS ACT

PREFACE

1. This act was cited as the Federal Symbols Act One, MMXVII.
2. The citation shall be changed to National Symbols Act, 1 John 1 c. 2
3. The short title for this act is National Symbols Act, 2017.

NAMING CONVENTIONS

1. When writing the names of the nation, one must follow these guidelines:
 - a. In English:
 - i. 3rd Kingdom of Baustralia
 - ii. 3rd Kingdom of Baustralia
 - iii. Baustralia
 - iv. Third Kingdom of Baustralia
 - v. THIRD KINGDOM OF BAVSTRALIA
 - vi. BAVSTRALIA
 - vii. 3RD KINGDOM OF BAVSTRALIA
 - viii. 3RD KINGDOM OF BAVSTRALIA
 - b. In French:
 - i. 3^{ième} Royaume de Baustralie
 - ii. 3ième Royaume de Baustralie
 - iii. Troisième Royaume de Baustralie
 - iv. Baustralie
 - c. In Latin:

i. TERTIVS REGNVM BAVSTRALIA

2. The same rules apply to the motto:

a. In English:

i. If you wish for peace, prepare for war

ii. IF YOY WISH FOR PEACE, PREPARE FOR WAR

b. In Latin:

i. SI VIS PACEM PARA BELLVM

ii. Si uis pacem para bellum

FLAG ETIQUETTE

1. The national flag may not touch the ground. If in event, the flag does touch the ground, it must be burnt. One boerc must also be payed to the crown.

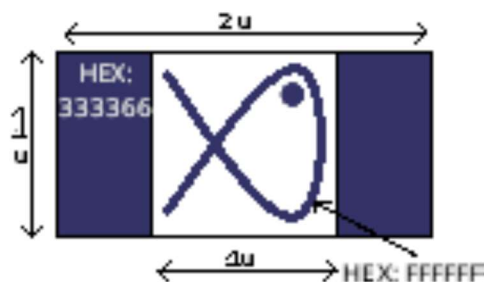


Figure 1.1 - Horizontal

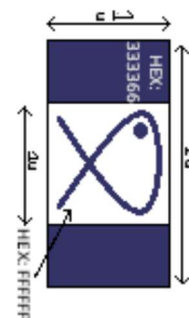


Figure 1.2 - Vertical

2. Any flags must be designed like Figure 1.1, and Figure 1.2
3. The flags must be in this order from right to left:

Foreign Flags, H.M. Territories, Mild Pond, Forest Creek, Norfolk, Flavora, Landspotter, Wooler, Greystone County, New Texas

The Baustrialian Flag will always be centered, and in front of the other flags.
