AN ACT REGARDING BLACKMAIL AND IMMUNITY OF
LAW OF HIS MAJESTY THE KING

PREFACE

1. Blackmail shall be defined as “the action of demanding money from someone in return for not revealing compromising information about them” (Blackmail 2005)
2. This Act shall be known as the Blackmail Act 2019.
3. This shall be compiled into the Criminal Code.

TERMS

4. His Majesty, as the source and seat of all justice, is considered exempt from law.
5. This Act shall make exemption to this, where His Majesty can be tried for treason, will the case being cited as Parliament v. Rex for Blackmail.
